## FAQS

- **When are the presentations?**
  - **IntraCare Medical Center:** Presentations are generally the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of the month. *There may be an exception if the date is near a holiday.*
  - **IntraCare North:** Presentations are generally the 1<sup>st</sup> Friday of the month. *There may be an exception if the date is near a holiday.*
  - Presentations are from 9:00 - 10:30 am unless the topic is Ethics. Ethics' presentations last three (3) hours and run from 8:30 - 11:30 am.
  - Registration/Networking/Continental Breakfast begin **15** minutes prior to start time (30 minutes prior to an ethics' training).
  
- **Do I need to register to attend?** Pre-registration is **REQUIRED** for the **Ethics Trainings**. After the calendar for the upcoming year is posted on the website, the registration form will be available at: [www.intracare.org](http://www.intracare.org), click on "CEU Schedule." Please complete and submit the form as instructed. You do not need to register to attend other trainings.
  
- **Who can attend?** Presentations are open to the community and most target professionals who work with children and adolescents.
  
- **How much does it cost?** There is no charge for the presentation or for the CEU certificate.
  
- **Which CEU credits are available?** The CEU credits are provided by IntraCare Medical Center Hospital. CEUs are available for those licensed in social work or as LPCs, LMFTs or LCDCs.
  
- **What if I don't need CEUs?** You are still welcome to attend. The CEU certificate can serve as your proof of attendance if you need that.
  
- **Does it matter which location I attend?** No, presentations are at IntraCare Medical Center (7601 Fannin, Houston 77054) or IntraCare North (1120 Cypress Station Drive, Houston 77090). You may attend either location.
  
- **Anything else I need to know?** Yes. If you arrive later than **15 minutes** after the presentation begins, we will not be able to provide you with a CEU certificate.
