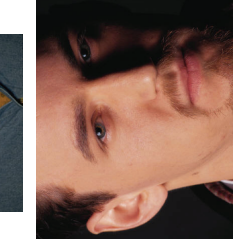
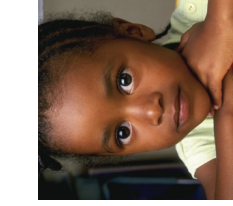

Located in north Houston, IntraCare North Hospital serves the greater Houston area, it provides a continuum of behavioral health services for children, adolescents and adults including:

- Psychiatric and Chemical Dependency Services
- Assessment and evaluation, 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- Crisis stabilization
- Education groups
- Social and therapy services
- Activities therapy
